The BARIGO STEEL MEL series reflects that apart from familiar, traditional styles of yacht design it is minimalist, straight-lined design which has increasingly asserted



itself in the world of high-value yachts. The BARIGO STEEL MEL series of ship's instruments fits seamlessly into this new direction of style – whether for motor yachts or sailing yachts. It is thrilling that BARIGO did not 'only' design an exquisite analog stainless steel clock and weather station but first ever has added a backlight system with electroluminescent foils. This innovative lighting technique illuminates the full dial surface, giving the impression of a light

object during night-time, and of a fully white dial during daytime, fulfilling its stainless steel/white dial design approach at all times. Mounted into the cabin the BARIGO STEEL MEL series reveals its information without the need of additional light which might disturb the atmosphere, sleeping crew or the helmsman and as a perfect side effect it helps to orientate within the cabin in total darkness.

The cold backlight of the EL foils allows for the first time to add a Thermometer to the weather station. The BARIGO STEEL MEL Series has a low power consumption and can even be used in surroundings where the availability of energy might be critical.

The BARIGO STEEL MEL series consist of two individual instruments, a clock and a weather station with Barometer, Thermometer and Hygrometer and come with a mounting system to fix the instruments into the cabin and a small separate inverter box to connect it to the 12-V board net through the top-hat mounting rail.
